

| Visual / Graphic Illustration | Step# | Description/Method   |
| FIG 1                         | 1     | Remove Front bumper  |
| 280 280 C                     | 2     | Find the centre of the crash beam and mark, then measure 280mm and mount the top brackets as shown in FIG 1.Adjust the bracket so that the distance from top of bracket to top of crash bean is 50mm as shown in Fig 1 |
| B A FIG 2                     | 3     | Now fit the bottom brackets as shown in Fig2. Drivers side shown , do the same on opposite side. Brackets are marked D for driver side and P for passenger side.   |
| U                             | 4     | Once the brackets are on then place the nudge bar on the brackets and check that it is center and level.   |

| FIG 7  | 7      | Now replace the bumper carefully over the brackets being careful to not scratch the bumper Grill , the top brackets will protrude through the top grill. This requires minimum 2 people to fit bumper back.               |
| Chery Pinetown © 031 713 1250  FIG 8  M8 Nickel black hardware and then use the M8 black plastic caps. | 8      | Once the Bumper is replaced you can fit the Nudge bar onto the brackets , centralise and tighten using the M Nickel Black hardware on the top and bottom brackets. Finish it it off with the M8 black plastic caps, Fig 8 |

## Final step

Make sure bar is centralised and tighten all fasteners to specified torque.

M8= 22Nm , M10= 42Nm , M6= 9Nm.
